

HOOK

STEP 1

When wanting to move DAN-Boards, using our hook, simply attach the small curved end to a handle or a hole in your DAN-Board.

STEP 2

Stand up streight holding the handle end of the hook and pull in the direction you want to move the board.

Often its much easier to handle if you are two people moving it with each your own hook in opposit corners of the board.





SINGLE CONNECTOR PLUS CONNECTOR

STEP 1

Place the bottom plastic part of your SINGLE or PLUS connector underneath the boards you want to connect, fitting the bolt towers to the holes places in the corners of your DAN-Board.



Place the metal top part of the connector accross the board, matching the holes to thoes of the bolt towers in the bottom

plastic part.

STEP 3

Add bolts in each hole to fasten the connection. Make sure to not tighten the bolts all the way down as the whole connector needs space to move and flex when in use.

Overtightening can cause breakage.

DO NOT USE electric powertools to tighten the bolts.

HANDLE CONNECTOR

STEP 1

Lift up the boards you want to connect making them slope slightly, make sure they are placed edge to edge as they need to be close together to install the connector.

STEP 2

Take the handle connector and push it in at an angle underneath your first boards handle until its all the way in as shown in the picture.


Due to the angle and lift of the board you can now press the connector over the other boards handle.

STEP 3

Lay the boards down flat again, the connector is now in place.

To remove the connector, simply lift the boards slightly again and remove the connector in the same manner as it was installed.

(For removal the boards have to be pushed close together again)





U-CONNECTOR

STEP 1

Place your DAN-Board close together and aligned on a none hard surface, making them ready for connection / anchoring via a U-CONNECTOR.

STEP 2

Match the connector with the holes in the corners of the DAN-Board and push the U-CONNECTOR slightly into the ground using your hands.

STEP 3

Use your foot to press the connector all the way in, securing the boards in place.

For removal simply pull out the connector.

If stuck you can use one of our Hooks to help pull the U-CONNECTOR free.
